## Baldwin Park to Host Independence Day Spectacular and Fireworks Show July 1

*City Reminds Residents of the Dangers of Illegal Fireworks*

**BALDWIN PARK, CA** - The City of Baldwin Park and Baldwin Park Unified School District invite residents, families and friends to join in 4th of July celebrations at the Baldwin Park Independence Day Spectacular on Saturday, July 1, at Sierra Vista High School, [3600 Frazier Avenue](#), Baldwin Park, CA.

The festivities begin at 5:30 p.m. with showgoers getting to partake in free activities like carnival rides, giant slides, a mechanical bull and a magic show beginning at 7:30 p.m. There will also be food vendors and a live concert for attendees to enjoy! The concert will begin at 6:30 p.m. featuring Aeromyth, an Aerosmith tribute band. The evening will close with a spectacular fireworks show beginning promptly at 9:30 p.m. Showgoers are encouraged to bring a lawn chair or blanket for the event.

“Our annual Independence Day Spectacular has become a yearly tradition for many of our Baldwin Park families and friends, and we are excited to provide residents with a fun-packed celebration yet again,” said Baldwin Park Mayor Emmanuel J. Estrada. “We encourage residents to refrain from using illegal fireworks as it can cause fires, serious injuries and disturbances to people and pets. Safety is always our top priority, especially as we celebrate the 4th of July. We have an unbeatable, professional fireworks show you will not want to miss.”

California has zero tolerance for the sale and use of illegal fireworks. Any fireworks not approved and labeled "Safe and Sane" by the State Fire Marshal are considered illegal in California. Violators could be fined up to \$50,000 and/or up to one year in jail. Illegal fireworks include:

- Sky rockets
- Bottle rockets
- Roman candles
- Aerial shells
- Firecrackers
- Other fireworks that explode, go into the air or move on the ground in an uncontrollable manner

The community can still enjoy “Safe and Sane” fireworks, which are permitted in Baldwin Park and can be purchased from a State Fire Marshal-licensed retail stand between noon on June 28 and noon on July 6. The following locations are State Fire Marshal-licensed retailers of “Safe and Sane” fireworks located in Baldwin Park:

Fireworks should only be used outdoors, never pointed or thrown at another person, and used at a safe distance from other people and away from buildings, vehicles, dry grass and other flammable objects.
