Similar to the amazing Summer Concerts in the Park performances, Baldwin Park has prepared an unbeatable line-up for upcoming concerts at Maine Avenue. Maine Avenue Opening Night will feature Banda Machos, a Regional Mexican band originally from Villa Corona, in the state of Jalisco. Banda Machos specializes in the Technobanda genre and are best known for popularizing the Quebradita dancing style that became popular in the 1990s in Mexico and the United States.

Following Banda Machos, Jovanny Cadena will take the South Stage on Aug. 17. Jovanny Cadena, a songwriter from La Paz, Baja California Sur, and his band, Jovanny Cadena and His Private Style, were riding the top of the Regional Mexican charts and touring steadily.
