Kaiser Permanente and the City of Baldwin Park Collaborate on Upcoming Vaccination Event

Baldwin Park, Calif. (Wednesday, May 5, 2021) – The City of Baldwin Park and Kaiser Permanente have partnered up to host a temporary COVID-19 vaccination site located at Esther Snyder Community Center, 4100 Baldwin Park Blvd., Baldwin Park, CA 91706, with hours of operation Monday-Friday 7:00 A.M. – 7:00 P.M. and Saturdays 7:00 A.M. – 3:00 P.M. **Members of the media are invited to attend press day on May 13th from 9:00 A.M. – 10:00 A.M.** Residents of Baldwin Park, elected officials and Kaiser leadership will be in attendance.

All residents of Baldwin Park and Kaiser Permanente members are eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. The City of Baldwin Park is fighting hard to get multiple vaccination sites for its residents. Baldwin Park has recently hosted five (5) vaccination events and is continuing to host more soon.

Due to the City's robust vaccination operations, over 45.6 percent of residents have received the vaccine versus the 50 percent LA County average. As of May 1st 49,000 people received the vaccine, and today, the City anticipates inoculating over 50,000 locals.

Mayor Emmanuel J. Estrada said, "Our goal in the City of Baldwin Park is to encourage our residents to get vaccinated for their safety and the safety of others in the community. We are continuing to grow partnerships with organizations, elected officials, and companies to make more vaccination sites available to our residents. We hope that the residents are happy with the current amount of vaccination events and sites, and we'll continue to get more for them."
