Together they are hosting a COVID-19 vaccine event on Monday, April 19, 2021, from 10:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. The vaccination event will take place at the Church of the Redeemer located at 3739 Monterey Avenue in Baldwin Park.

COVID-19 vaccines are FREE regardless of insurance or immigration status to everyone over sixteen years of age. Anyone under 18 years of age requires a legal parent or guardian consent and must be present.

Mayor Emmanuel J. Estrada said, "We are excited to collaborate with Rite Aid and Church of the Redeemer to increased access to vaccinations that will help protect even more of our community. As a city, Baldwin Park plays an important role in supporting community health. Making sure our residents can get vaccinated is critical to beating this virus.
