CITY OF BALDWIN PARK'S BAR ON RENTAL INCREASES DUE TO PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

BALDWIN PARK, CALIF. (Thursday, April 2, 2020) – Baldwin Park today joined dozens of other California cities in temporarily barring rent increases due to the public health emergency. The City took a bold action to prohibit rent increases as a preventive measure, which will protect the rental market and safeguard the health of all of our residents.

Under the authority of the Director of the Emergency Services, rents covered under the Baldwin Park Rent Stabilization Ordinance will not increase from April 2, 2020, to the end of the declared emergency. Landlords who violate this ordinance face fines, charges, or legal prosecution.

The City continues to act swiftly to update residents on services and resources as information becomes more available.

Baldwin Park cares deeply about all the residents in our City. Especially renters who are struggling during this unprecedented time. On behalf of the Mayor and City Council, we want to express our gratitude to the Baldwin Park residents for following the County and State quarantines.
