The Waste Management Baldwin Park Scholarship program is open to graduating high school seniors residing in the City of Baldwin Park that have overcome adversity in their quest to graduate and pursue their educational goals.

Students must have a current semester/grading period GPA of 2.5 or higher, complete an essay, attend an interview (virtually or in-person), and provide 2 letters of reference to be considered.

Scholarships ranging in the amounts of \$500 to \$2500 will be awarded at the senior recognition assembly.

If selected, scholarship awardees must be able to provide proof of registration or acceptance to an educational institution. Award check will be provided to the institution on behalf of the recipient, not to the individual. Scholarship will be forfeited if proof of enrollment is not received by November 1, 2025.
