Baldwin Park Announces Spring Fest & Egg Hunt with New Attractions for 2025

BALDWIN PARK, CA – The City of Baldwin Park is excited to invite families to the highly anticipated Spring Fest & Egg Hunt on Saturday, April 19, at 9 a.m. This beloved community tradition will be held at Morgan Park (4100 Baldwin Park Blvd.) and promises a day of fun, entertainment and excitement for attendees of all ages.

“We’re thrilled to bring back our annual Spring Fest with new attractions and entertainment for the whole family to enjoy,” said Baldwin Park Mayor Alejandra Avila. “This event continues to be one of our most popular community gatherings, and we’re particularly proud to offer an inclusive egg hunt option that ensures all children can participate in the festivities.”

The highlight of the event will be the free egg hunt starting at 10:45 a.m., featuring over 20,000 eggs hidden throughout designated areas of the park. This year, 32 special golden eggs will be hidden, with eight winners per section receiving spring baskets filled with goodies. To provide an equal experience for all egg hunters, parents and bystanders will not be allowed in hunt areas.

New for 2025, the Spring Fest proudly introduces an inclusive egg hunt for children with disabilities. Participants must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult and register by April 11. Registration is [available online](#).

The event also features several exciting new attractions, including a beautiful interactive butterfly exhibit, fun inflatables for kids to bounce and play on and a dedicated bubble zone for endless bubble fun and activities. A professional magic show will entertain visitors with amazing tricks and illusions throughout the day.

From 9-11 a.m., children can express their creativity at the Bunny Craft Workshop. Families can also capture the memory of this special day with photos with the bunny available for \$5.

“Spring Fest is more than just an egg hunt — it’s a celebration of community and the joyful spirit of springtime,” added Mayor Avila. “We’ve worked hard to create an inclusive event where everyone can enjoy the festivities.”
