Baldwin Park to Host Earth Day and Arbor Day Celebration on April 26

BALDWIN PARK, CA — The City of Baldwin Park invites the community to participate in a special Earth Day and Arbor Day Celebration on Saturday, April 26, from 8 a.m.-12 p.m. at the Cruz Baca TransCenter and City Parking Structure (3825 Downing Avenue, Baldwin Park, CA 91706). This community-focused event combines environmental education with hands-on beautification activities and services.

“This combined celebration represents our City’s community pride and ongoing commitment to environmental stewardship,” said Baldwin Park Mayor Alejandra Avila. “By bringing residents together to enhance our public spaces, we’re fostering civic pride while also providing valuable environmental services for our community.”

The event will feature a Clean-Up & Beautification Day where volunteers can help improve public spaces throughout the city. All volunteers will receive lunch as a gesture of appreciation for their efforts. Participants are encouraged to wear work clothes with closed-toe shoes, and those under age 14 must be accompanied by adults. Volunteer check-in begins at 9 a.m.

In addition to beautification activities, the event will provide several environmental services for Baldwin Park residents with proof of residency. These include a bulky item drop-off station (limit of 4 items, no hazardous materials or commercial vehicles), free mulch, oil containers, e-waste collection, paper shredding (limited to one banker’s box), fruit tree giveaway and an electric bike demonstration zone. These services support the City’s commitment to sustainability while offering practical solutions for residents’ everyday environmental needs.

The celebration will also include tree planting in a Baldwin Park neighborhood and planting of perennial flowers at Morgan Park.

“Earth Day and Arbor Day celebrations bring our community together around a shared purpose,” added Mayor Avila. “These events strengthen neighborhood bonds while beautifying our shared spaces. Whether planting trees alongside neighbors, accessing eco-friendly resources or simply learning about sustainability, this day represents our community’s commitment to building a better City for all.”
