Arrest of Former Baldwin Park Police Officer Following Filing of Criminal Charges

SUMMARY OF EVENTS

On November 6, 2025, following the filing of a criminal case and the issuance of an arrest warrant, former Baldwin Park Police Department, Police Officer Andres Villalobos, was taken into custody at approximately 7:50 p.m., without incident. Mr. Villalobos was transported to and booked at the Baldwin Park Police Department and subsequently transferred to the custody of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department. The underlying investigation concerns allegations of misappropriation of funds from the Baldwin Park Police Department Association.

The filed criminal complaint lists 32 counts: 2 counts of Possession of a destructive device, 1 of Commercial burglary, and 29 counts of Grand theft

This matter remains an active and ongoing investigation. To protect the integrity of the case consistent with California law, no additional details are being released at this time. Further inquiries regarding court proceedings should be directed to the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office.

Presumption of Innocence: All charges are allegations only. Every defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty in a court of law.

The Baldwin Park Police Department is committed to professionalism, transparency, and accountability. We recognize the public's trust is essential to effective policing, and we will continue to cooperate with prosecutorial authorities while upholding all legal and due-process requirements.
