DOUBLE HOMICIDE AND ATTEMPTED MURDER INVESTIGATION

Location: 12700 Block of Royston Street, Baldwin Park

SUMMARY OF EVENTS:

In the early morning hours of November 17, 2025, Baldwin Park Police officers were dispatched to a residence on the 12700 block of Royston Street following reports of a suspicious person and a possible deceased individual.

When officers arrived at approximately 4:58 AM, they encountered three unharmed individuals outside the home who reported a shooting had taken place inside. Officers immediately entered the residence and found three gunshot victims. Officers provided emergency medical aid until Los Angeles County Fire Department paramedics arrived.

Despite life-saving efforts, two victims, 61-year-old Yulan Wang and her 61-year-old husband Qiufu Jiang, succumbed to their injuries at the scene. A 10-year-old girl was transported to a trauma center with critical injuries, where she is currently receiving treatment and is listed in critical condition. The three family members who were outside the residence at the time, two adult males and one juvenile male, were not harmed.

Through investigative efforts conducted jointly with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Homicide Bureau, detectives identified 35-year-old Qihao Jin as the suspect responsible for this violent attack. Investigators determined that Jin made entry into his estranged wife's family residence while armed with a firearm and opened fire on the victims. His estranged wife was not home during the attack.

Following the shooting, Jin fled the scene in a vehicle. Baldwin Park detectives and LASD Homicide investigators worked through the day and night to identify Jin's vehicle and coordinate a multi-agency search.

On the evening of November 17, 2025, Anaheim Police Department officers located Jin and his vehicle in the 100 block of Vermont Street in Anaheim. Jin was found deceased inside the vehicle from what appears to be a self-inflicted gunshot wound.

The Baldwin Park Police Department wishes to express deep appreciation to the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Homicide Bureau for their outstanding investigative support and partnership in resolving this tragic case. We also commend the Anaheim Police Department for their vigilance in locating the suspect vehicle and extend our thanks to the San Gabriel Police Department and all other law enforcement partners who contributed resources and assistance during this critical investigation.

While the suspect has been located and this incident is effectively resolved, detectives continue to process evidence and conduct follow-up investigations. Additional details will not be released at this time to preserve the integrity of the ongoing investigative process.
